

Based on the testimony of the vocational expert, the undersigned finds that, beginning April 23, 2013, the claimant has been capable of making a successful adjustment to work that exists in significant numbers in the national economy. A finding of "not disabled" is therefore appropriate under the framework of the above-cited rule.

16. The claimant's disability ended April 23, 2013 (20 CFR 404.1594(f)(8) and 416.994(b)(5)(vii)).

DECISION

Based on the application for a period of disability and disability insurance benefits filed on March 30, 2012, the claimant was disabled under §§216(i) and 223(d) of the Act, from June 28, 2011 through April 22, 2013.

Based on the application for SSI filed on March 30, 2012, the claimant was disabled under §1614(a)(3)(A) of the Act, from June 28, 2011 through April 22, 2013.

The component of the Social Security Administration responsible for authorizing SSI will advise the claimant regarding the non-disability requirements for these payments, and if eligible, the amount and the months for which payment will be made.
