I was advised by Dan Wallis that you were inquiring as to whether or not better identification of the speaker can be made on the transcripts heard before Judge Thomas Meyer.

Unfortunately, when the court reporters are preparing a transcript from the electronic recording system, if the parties present do not identify themselves or the presiding judge does not ask the parties to identify themselves or the presiding judge does not identify any of the speakers, it is impossible for us to know who is present. We cannot guess who is present either. If no one identifies themselves, the court reporters designate the speaker as VOICE or SPEAKER.
