The first 3 Exhibits attaching to the Motion to Reconsider are

- 1) Exhibit 1: A document named "Clear and Convincing Evidence of Fraud on the Court in 12LA178"
- 2) Exhibit 2: A document called "Clear and Convincing Evidence of Fraud on the Court in 17LA377 During Gooch Representation"
