This 4/1/2021 was originally created on 4/14/2021 and emailed to me. (See attached named: 2021-04-14\_1241 PM\_RECV-Collins\_Invoice 2020031 from Stacey A Collins.pdf)

The 4/1/2021 was emailed to me a second time on 3/24/2022. (See attached named: 2022-03-24\_1423 PM\_RECV-Collins 17 LA 377.pdf)

I ran a file comparison between the two and only 1 item changed. The signature. (See attached named: [Compare Report] 04 01 21 R201(TAM)\_17 LA 377.pdf)

In the ROP\_Vol\_1\_of\_1\_230421\_1628\_8FF9DDF1.pdf sent to the appellate clerk:

- 1. The table of contents refers to the wrong date (4/23/2021)
- 2. The signature appears to match the first version sent to me on 4/14/2021 but the signature page itself appears to be rotated 180 degrees.
- 3. I tried to run a comparison with the ROP sent to the appellate clerk and it had 183 differences.

This way of comparing the files using the adobe software is new to me. 183 differences was simply too much to figure out what was what in a short time. And would need considerable study on my part to figure it out if anything substantial changed before commenting on it.

I did not include the comparison that I did with the one sent to the appellate clerk but I did extract the pages and attached below so you can see what I am talking about.
