ORDER OF ADJUDICATION OF INDIRECT CIVIL CONTEMPT

This cause coming on to be heard on Plaintiff/Petitioner Wife's amended petition for a finding of indirect civil contempt for failing to obey multiple court orders, the court having previously heard testimony and evidence, and having considered all relevant pleadings and arguments of counsel, and now being fully advised:

THE COURT FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) This court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter herein.
- 2) This court entered a memorandum decision and order dated February 16, 2012 which was given to Husband and which ordered Husband to do as follows:
 "The court therefore orders and sets temporary maintenance at \$7,000 per month, payable directly to Wife, commencing 1 March 2012." (Pl. Ex. 1, p. 10)

 "The court orders temporary child support as follows: Husband shall pay to Wife directly the sum of \$1,100 per month..." (Pl. Ex. 1, pp. 10-11)
- 3) For reasons stated in its Memorandum Opinion and Order of this date, the court finds that Husband did not pay the above described support and maintenance obligations in a timely fashion, and that making provisions for all court approved setoffs and distributions, Husband is \$16,800 in arrears in temporary liquidated maintenance and child support payments as of this date.
- 4) For reasons stated in its Memorandum Opinion and Order of this date, the court finds that Husband's failure to comply with the court's orders is knowing and willful.
- 5) The conduct of Husband has defeated and impaired the rights and interest of Wife, and further, has impeded and obstructed the court in its administration of justice. Husband has been afforded his rights to set forth his defenses.
- 6) After considering all the evidence, pleadings, and arguments, the court finds Husband in willful, indirect civil contempt of this court.

7) Husband may purge himself of this contempt and dissolve the contempt finding by paying the sum of \$16,800 to Wife as payment of the obligations specified above.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

Sentencing on this adjudication of indirect civil contempt is set for October 11, 2012 at 1:30 PM.
