



STIPULATION

Petitioner, KIMBERLY POPOVICH and Respondent, THOMAS POPOVICH hereby stipulate as follows:

1. We are husband and wife, having been married on July 18, 1998.
2. We have lived separate and apart as husband and wife a continuous period of time of not less than six months.
3. There has been an irretrievable breakdown of our marriage and it is our desire to obtain a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage without the proof of fault, and without contest, and we hereby waive and relinquish the two (2) year requirement of 750 ILCS 5/401 (a)(2).
4. This waiver is being made knowingly and without coercion, in order to obtain the divorce, and we wish to be bound by this waiver.
