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

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

COMPLAINT TO DETERMINE PARENTAGE

NOW COMES, Nicole Bazilewich, the Complainant, by and through her attorney, THOMAS F. BAKER, State's Attorney for McHenry County, Illinois, by and through his duly appointed Assistant, Charles E. Crouse, as and for her Complaint to Establish the Parentage of the Defendant, David Gagnon, as the father of Complainant's child pursuant to Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 40, Paragraph 2501, et seq., she charges:

- 1. That the Complainant is a resident of McHenry County, Illinois, and resides at 12111 Bigelow Ave, Apt. B, Hebron, IL 60034. That the Defendant is a resident of McHenry County, Illinois, and he resides at 1016 Elder Ave., McHenry, IL 60050.
- 2. That the Complainant is the mother of the child named Colin J. Bazilewich born in McHenry County on June 26, 1990.
- 3. That the Complainant is not now married and has never been married to the Defendant. That the Defendant is the father of the child born to the Complainant, and said child was born out of wedlock.

- 4. That this cause of action is brought pursuant to Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 40, Par. 2501, et seq. to establish the father-child relationship between Defendant and the child and to establish and enforce the Defendant's liability for the support, maintenance, education, and welfare of said child as well as to recover expenses for Plaintiff incurred during her pregnancy, confinement, and recovery including, but not limited to all doctors' fees, lost time from work, and other expenses and for attorneys' fees incurred as a result of the bringing and prosecution of this action.
- 5. That Illinois law mandates that the Defendant is responsible to contribute to the prenatal and postnatal loss of income, expenses, pharmaceutical bills, medical bills, hospital bills, and lost time from work as a result of Plaintiff's pregnancy and birth of the child. That the Defendant should be required by this court to pay for these expenses of the mother and child and to reimburse the plaintiff for the aforesaid expenses and bills incurred as a result of the pregnancy and birth of said child.
- 6. That the child is entitled under the laws of the United States and State of Illinois and their respective constitutions to all the rights, privileges, and immunities afforded a child born in wedlock including, but not limited to support, health care, inheritance, education, and all other rights due a legitimate child born of wedlock.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays as follows:

A. For a judgment in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant, establishing the Defendant as the father of the child, Colin J. Bazilewich.

- B. That the Defendant be ordered to pay for all expenses for the care, delivery, and post-delivery needs of the Plaintiff and the child as a result of the birth of said child.
